



On March 25, 2020, by the authority afforded him under Idaho Code §56-1003(7) Director Dave Jeppesen, of the Idaho Department of Health and Welfare, issued "Order of the Director – Order to Self-Isolate", in which he directed that "...ALL INDIVIDUALS LIVING IN THE STATE OF IDAHO ... SELF-ISOLATE AT THEIR PLACE OF RESIDENCE. EXCEPT THAT THEY MAY LEAVE TO...WORK FOR ESSENTIAL BUSINESS AND GOVERNMENT SERVICES;". As this Order applies to all residents and businesses within the State of Idaho it encompasses the operations of PFB Custom Homes Group's facilities in Meridian, ID.

To provide further guidance he provided definitions of "**Essential Activities**", "**Essential Businesses**", "**Minimum Basic Operations**" and "**Essential Travel**" as well as making reference to the CISA document, issued by the Department of Homeland Security on March 19, 2020. Upon review of the Order, its included definitions as well as the CISA document, we have determined that the operations of PFB Custom Homes Group are exempted from the Order due to both our manufacture and distribution of forest products as well as our construction activities.

PFB Custom Homes Group is committed to maintaining the ongoing safe operations of our facility to support our employees and communities as we work together to fulfill our critical infrastructure requirements during these challenging times. Further we understand the parameters in which those operations must be maintained and have taken the steps required in the Order to be in compliance.

To that end, based on our understanding of known, local, state and federal guidelines, PFB Custom Homes Group through its regular operating activities is considered Essential Business, exempt from shelter in place executive orders, permitting us to maintain operations within applicable guidelines. We will continue to monitor and review new guidelines as well as work in conjunction with applicable governmental authorities to ensure that they support our endeavors to remain open in a manner that meets the needs of our communities, customers, employees and suppliers.
